

### **Fly America Act**

In order for a flight to be in compliance with the Fly America Act, the code of a U.S. flag air carrier must be noted as part of the flight number on the airline ticket, flight coupon (boarding pass), or passenger receipt. Each airline has a two letter alpha code. For instance, US Airways has a code of "US". This two digit code will appear just to the left of the flight number. From the list below, you will be able to compare airlines codes on the ticket with those on the list and thereby be able to ascertain whether or not the flight is on a US flag air carrier.
